The City of Whitewright Texas is accepting applications for a full-time TCOLE certified Peace Officer. This position will be responsible for enforcing federal, state and local laws and ordinances related to the protection of life and property, responding to citizen's calls for assistance, directing and controlling traffic, preventing criminal activity, apprehending criminal offenders, conducting preliminary investigation, writing reports, promoting crime prevention and community relations, investigating disturbances, arresting violators and performing other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- High school diploma or GED
- Valid Driver License with a good driving record
- Active TCOLE Peace Officer license
- Pass a thorough background investigation
- Pass a medical exam, psychological exam, and drug screening
- Must complete a City application to be considered
- Criminal record must be limited to:
 - Never been on court ordered community supervision or probation for any criminal offense above the grade of Class B misdemeanor or a Class B misdemeanor within the last ten years from the date of the court order.
 - Has never been convicted of an offense above the grade of a Class B misdemeanor or a Class B misdemeanor within the last ten years.
 - Has never been convicted or placed on community supervision in any court of an offense involving family violence as defined under chapter 71, Texas Family Code.
